

Poppy Contests for Auxiliary Members
Deadline: February 20, 2010

Artistic Creation Contest Categories

- A. Centerpiece – the poppy must be the main flower even though other flowers may be used in the arrangement. Since it is a centerpiece, the judge should be able to view it from any direction.

- B. Corsage – the poppy must be the main flower. Consider the wear-ability of the corsage in regards to size. Limit corsage size to no larger than 4”x6”.

- C. Poppy Unique Display – the poppy must be the main flower, even though other flowers may be used. A display need not be visible from all sides, as in the rules for a centerpiece.

Judging is based on:

- A. Originality 25%
- B. Best use of the poppy 50%
- C. Overall appeal 25%

Awards

- A. The Junior, Senior & Class VI (award for students with special needs regardless of age) for centerpieces, corsages & displays.
- B. Corsages: Junior contest has 2 classes
 - Class I – up to age 12
 - Class II – ages 13-18

The Unit category winners will proceed onto the 5th District for judging. The entry needs to include a 3”x5” index card that has the winner's name, and if they're a junior or senior member. The Poppy Chairperson needs to attach a green entry slip that has been properly completed.
